Another line, let's call it Y, intersects Z and creates two angles. The one (b) is obviously bigger than 90° and is therefore obtuse. The other (a) is smaller than 90° and is therefore acute. These two angles are complementary, because they will always add up to 180° .

Supplementary andplementary Angles softschools

plementary angles form a right angle (L shape) and have a sum of 90° degrees. Supplementary angles form a straight line and have a sum of 180° degrees. If the relationship is given, you can subtract the given angle from the sum to determine the measure of the missing angle.
